

OctoFlow is a Chrome side panel productivity extension for individual salespeople. It helps a user track their own professional relationships, log their own outreach activity, and manage a personal to do list. It is a personal productivity tool. It does not integrate with, modify, or extract data from company systems.

PERMISSIONS REQUESTED AND WHY

storage	Saves the user's own notes, contacts, and settings in Chrome's local extension storage
alarms	Powers daily reminders and the focus timer completion notice
notifications	Shows productivity reminders as desktop notifications
sidePanel	Renders the app inside Chrome's built in side panel

SITE ACCESS AND WHY

OctoFlow requests no access to any corporate website or system and injects no scripts into any web page. Its only network access is to its own backend:

Google Firebase endpoints	firebaseapp.com, firestore.googleapis.com, identitytoolkit.googleapis.com, securetoken.googleapis.com: account sign in and optional cloud sync of the user's own data
hooks.slack.com	Optional Slack notifications the user configures themselves. Inactive unless the user sets it up.

DATA HANDLING

- The user's data (their contacts, notes, activity history, tasks) is stored locally in Chrome and optionally synced to Google Firebase under the user's own account
- Sign in uses an email and PIN flow through Google Identity Platform
- Encrypted in transit (TLS) and at rest on Google Cloud
- No data is sold or shared with third parties
- Users can delete their account and all data from Settings at any time

WHAT OCTOFLOW DOES NOT DO

- No collection of browsing history
- No keystroke logging
- No reading or scraping of corporate systems, email, or CRM data
- No remote code execution: all code ships inside the Chrome Web Store reviewed package
- No advertising or tracking SDKs

HOW TO ALLOW OCTOFLOW ON A MANAGED BROWSER

Google Admin console → Chrome browser → Apps and extensions → add the extension ID `aaobogaacakidgajkkfkafjoeelakdc` → set to Allow install (or approve the user's pending request). This follows standard Chrome Enterprise extension management.
